EDULUTION

transforming learning

With average class sizes of 50:1, and poor resources in schools, children really struggle to learn, particularly in subjects such as maths and science. Partnering with Edulution, we run four education centres covering 1,200 children. Through this programme we have seen an average improvement of 35% in maths exam results, as well as an overall increase of 10% in all other subjects



Gender Equality

Girls across the world often face greater barriers to success, and this is certainly no exception in South Luangwa. We try to readdress this balance through specialist Gender Clubs, designed to improve confidence and tackle sensitive issues such as consent and early marriage. We also make and distribute washable 'Ufulu' sanitary pads, and support girls and young women through sponsorship



School Support

In addition to our education programmes we also assist schools with infrastructure and construction. Project Luangwa has built 12 schools across four chiefdoms, and continues to help over 20 schools in total. From large projects such as toilet blocks or dormitories, to basic sanitation and electricity

How does tourism support communities and conservation in South Luangwa?

LCCF

The Luangwa Community and Conservation Fund was set up by a group of safari operators who wanted to insure that the proceeds of tourism were being fed back into local communities and conservation efforts



For all of our member lodges, an LCCF charge is included on a guest's bill, insuring that your stay is benefitting local families and wildlife through the activities of NGOs such as Project Luangwa

Sponsorship and Donations

Purely by staying with one of our member lodges you are supporting local schools and children. However, many visitors also go a step further and donate extra to the project, or sponsor a child, giving them a chance at realising their potential and attaining a better future



Ufulu Pads and Stoves

Visiting our shop in South Luangwa also lets you purchase a pack of washable sanitary pads for a girl, allowing her to save up to one week a month of lost school time. Alternatively you can also purchase an Eco-Stove, and support a local family with a safer and cleaner cooking option - saving time, improving health and reducing deforestation
